CASE STUDY: MARRICKVILLE WEST PUBLIC SCHOOL

The schools Secondhand Wonderland in 2017 raised over \$2,000 for the P&C's special projects and involved the whole local community. Over 25 stalls full of secondhand goodies, visitors also had the chance to revive with a coffee, tuck into an ice cream or even get their car washed.
