

TEMPORARY FENCE ARTWORK SUBMISSION



Terms and conditions of entry:

Carnegie Memorial Swimming Pool temporary fence artwork submission ('Submission') is being run by Glen Eira City Council ('Council') and will be on display on the hoarding around the construction site of Carnegie Memorial Swimming Pool.

- 1. By entering the Submission, entrants accept these terms and conditions of entry ('Conditions').
- 2. For eligibility to enter the Submission:
- (a) Drawings or paintings must be at least A4 size and submitted to the drop off points at Town Hall Service Centre or GESAC. If submitted online via scanned or photographed copy they should be high-resolution (more than 1MB).
- (b) The entrant must submit a valid entry to be determined by Council in its absolute discretion.
- 3. Entrants are permitted to submit up to two (2) artworks.
- 4. Council may require entrants to provide proof of parental or guardian's consent to enter the Submission (if they are under age 18); and proof of age. What is suitable for verification is at Council's absolute discretion.
- 5. To enter the Submission:
- (a) the entrant must submit a valid application entry online via www.gleneira.vic.gov.au; and
- (b) the entry must be submitted by Thursday 31 August 2023. Entries outside of this date will not be accepted unless Council extends the submission period, in which case notice will be provided on Council's website; www gleneira.vic.gov.au
- 6. Council will acknowledge receipt of entries by email.
- 7. Entries chosen to be displayed in the submission will be chosen by the Glen Eira panel. The panel reserves the right to disregard entries which they deem in their discretion to be offensive or discriminatory or which do not meet community standards.

- 8. Not all entries are guaranteed to be displayed in the Submission. All entries included in the Submission are at the absolute discretion of the panel. The panel decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 9. Entries must not include personal information that would or could identify a living person without the written consent of that person. Captions that accompany entries should note a first name and age of the entrant only. Only the entry form is to include the entrant's personal information.
- 10. All entrants consent and agree to Council displaying, publishing, reproducing (in whole or in part) and/or using any entries in its public spaces, on its website, on social media and in print media.
- 11. Council is not liable for late, lost, incomplete, invalid or incorrectly submitted entries, or illegible, corrupted or misdirected entries, claims or correspondence due to error, omission, alteration, tampering, deletion, theft, destruction, transmission interruption and communications failure or otherwise.

12.2 Privacy

The personal information requested in your entry form and as part of your submission is required primarily to enable you to participate in the Submission, and subject to Clause 3 will only be shared with those responsible for organising and conducting the Submission.
