## FEE SCHEDULE FOR PLANNING PERMITS, SUBDIVISION PERMITS PLANNING SCHEME AMENDMENTS AND PLANNING PROCESSES

Effective: 1 July 2022

All planning applications and requests have an associated fee. These fees are either set by the State Government or Council. The current value of a fee unit for 2022-2023 is \$15.29. Application fees must be paid before an application can be considered. The following fees apply to the various applications and requests.

<p>A minor pre-application advice request is for any proposal which comprises:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>alterations and extensions to an existing dwelling or commercial building;</li> <li>development of up to three dwellings on a lot;</li> <li>two lot subdivision;</li> <li>display advertising signage;</li> <li>reduce or waive the number of car parking spaces required under the Glen Eira Planning Scheme;</li> <li>change the use of land;</li> <li>applications defined as VicSmart; and</li> <li>similar small scale applications.</li> </ul>	<p>A major pre-application advice request is for any proposal which comprises:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>four dwellings or more;</li> <li>use and developments;</li> <li>mixed use applications;</li> <li>new commercial developments;</li> </ul>
