

* TITLE: Street Lighting
* ADOPTED BY: Glen Eira City Council

1. Objective

To provide adequate illumination for pedestrian and vehicular traffic in residential streets and public places within the city.

Note: It is not the role of Council to improve the level of safety within private properties through the provision of additional street lighting.

2. Policy

- In conjunction with the applicable power provider, Council will facilitate the provision of appropriate levels of lighting in streets and public places.
- The standard spacing for streetlights in residential streets will be one streetlight on every second power pole.
- Where necessary to provide adequate levels of illumination the Director of Infrastructure or his/her delegate is authorised to vary the spacing depending on:
 - The adjacent land use.
 - The spacing of poles.
 - The spacing and spread of street trees.
- In accordance with Policy No. 8.13 Use of Rights of Way, Council will not provide street lighting in laneways except at the cost of the adjoining property owners.
