- 6. Delivering events and activities that contribute to diverse, vibrant and prosperous public space.

Your grant application will be strengthened if it aligns with one or more themes in the Glen Eira Council and Community Plan 2017–2021:

- 1. Liveable and well designed a well-planned City that is a great place to be.
- 2. Accessible and well connected a City that is easy to move around, with safe travel options and walkable neighbourhoods.
- 3. Safe, healthy and inclusive a strong and safe community that brings people together and enhances health and wellbeing.
- 4. Clean and sustainable an attractive and sustainable environment for future generations.
- 5. Informed and engaged a well governed Council that is committed to transparency and engages residents in decision-making.
