Auditorium

Built in the 1920s, the Auditorium ballroom has a magnificent art deco leadlight window ceiling supported by white Corinthian columns.




- Audio visual system, including data projector and two motorised screens on stage, sound mixing desk and lighting console

Theatre style — capacity 480




Banquet style — capacity 300

Glen Eira Town Hall

Originally known as Caulfield Shire Hall, the building was designed by Shire surveyor Sydney Smith. The foundation stone was laid in December 1884 by Shire President J W Crosbie. A second storey and a portico were added in 1891.

In 1931, Caulfield Town Hall was remodelled to include the Auditorium and a neo-Grecian portico with Corinthian order columns. Local materials were used wherever possible. The project involved many local unemployed tradesmen, and was a major part of Council's local employment relief scheme during the Great Depression.
