Materials

Box (a shoe box is a good size)

Cardboard

Scissors

Paint and brush

Paper

Coloured pencils

Glue

Step I

Cut out tiny frames.

Make lots of different shapes and sizes.

Paint the frames different colours.

Draw some tiny pictures of your family and friends!







Step 2

When you have lots of tiny pictures, cut them out and stick them on to the coloured frames.



Paint your box so that it is a lovely space to view your work.

Step 4

Hang all the tiny paintings and drawings in you your gallery box. I used rolled up masking tape on the back of the pictures or you can glue them.

Invite your family and friends to view the opening!
