Youth Art Exhibition — Unity in Community

Terms and conditions of entry:

1. Eligibility

- a) Entrants must, live, work or study within the city of Glen Eira.
- b) Entrants must be between 5 and 25 years old. This age limit will be strictly enforced.
- c) Entrants under the age of 18 must obtain their parent or guardian's consent by way of signature where indicated below.

2. Entering the Exhibition

- a) Entries will only be accepted via the online registration form.
- b) Entries are limited to one per entrant.
- c) Entries must be the original artwork of the entrant and any entries considered to be works of plagiarism will not be accepted.
- d) Entries that depict violence, discrimination, sexually explicit or other inappropriate material will not be accepted.
- e) Entries must not have previously been awarded a prize in an event or competition held by Glen Eira City Council (Council).
- f) The entrant is solely responsible for Formatting of the entry is the responsibility of the entrant.
- g) By submitting an entry, all Entrants grant to Council a worldwide, fee-free, transferable licence to use their entry for any purpose relating to Council's functions, including by publishing their entry on Council's print and social media. All Entrants further consent to any act or omission by Council which would otherwise constitute a breach of their moral rights.

3. Other people's rights

- a) If an entry contains another individual's personal information (including their image) or another person's work, it is the Entrant's responsibility to seek consent from those individuals. Glen Eira City Council may disqualify an entry if it becomes aware that an individual has not consented to their personal information or their work being included in the entry.

4. Exhibition

- a) As well as providing the JPEG file as part of the entry requirement Artwork must be submitted at the Town Hall Gallery at a determined time and location for the work to be displayed in the exhibition and considered for prizes as set out in this clause. Arrangements to deliver a copy of the Artwork to Council will be advised to entrants by email.
- b) If the physical exhibition cannot proceed due to Covid restrictions, the exhibition will be moved online at the Instagram page: [ge_yae_unityincommunity](https://www.instagram.com/ge_yae_unityincommunity). This is why we require a photographic version of your artwork as a part of your submission.
- c) All accepted entries will be exhibited, and entrants acknowledged by name, on the Glen Eira City Council Youth Services Instagram Page (Instagram).
- d) At Council's discretion, entries may also be exhibited at a Council premises or on any of Council's internet platforms.

5. Prizes

- a) For the purposes of determining Prize allocation, the Entrants will be sorted into categories as follows:
 - i. Category 1: ages 5-9
 - ii. Category 2: ages 10-13
 - iii. Category 3: ages 14-17
 - iv. Category 4: ages 18-25
- b) The best entry in Category 1, will receive an Art Supply Hamper to the value of \$100.00. The best entry in Category 2 will receive a \$150.00 Westfield voucher. The best entry in Category 3, will receive a \$250.00 Westfield Voucher. The best entry in Category 4 will receive a \$300.00 Westfield voucher
- c) Winners will be determined by a Judge with industry experience. Such determination is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- d) All winners will be contacted in writing, and a gift card sent to them, using the contact details on this form. Winners will also be publicly announced via Instagram and names of the winners published in the Glen Eira News, Instagram, and Glen Eira City Council Youth Service's Facebook page.
- e) Winners may not exchange their Prizes for money, and Council is not responsible for any loss suffered or incurred by any person in connection with or arising from redemption of any Prize.

6. General

- a) If for any reason any aspect of this Exhibition or Competition is not capable of running as planned, including by reason of tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failure or any cause beyond the control of Council, Council may in its sole discretion cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Exhibition or Competition, or invalidate any affected entries, if required.
- b) The personal information collected on this form is collected by Glen Eira City Council to administer participation in the Inspiration in Isolation Art Exhibition. If you do not provide this information, it may not be possible to include your entry in the Exhibition or the Competition.
