The new Councillors will be officially sworn in at a special online ceremony Monday 9 November at 6.30pm. Community members can watch the ceremony live via the streaming service on Council's website.

The new Council's first public meeting to conduct the general business of the Council will be held on Tuesday 24 November at 7.30pm.
