Have your say on the draft Our Climate Emergency Strategy 2021-2025

In late 2020, Council asked for ideas and feedback from Glen Eira community members on how we could help them to reduce carbon emissions at home, work, school or in the community.

We had a fantastic response to the consultation. Feedback indicates that climate change is seen as a genuine problem and that people recognise their day-to-day habits have an impact on the environment.

The draft Our Climate Emergency Strategy 2021–2025 and associated Action Plan is now available for feedback.

Glen Eira Mayor Cr Margaret Esakoff said the draft Strategy outlines Council's commitment to strong and fast action on climate change.

"We will lead by example and work hard to cut our own carbon footprint. We will support the Glen Eira community by educating, informing, mobilising and facilitating a transition to a low-carbon way of life," she said.

"Through the principles outlined in this Strategy, we will work together to create a sustainable, liveable, equitable and resilient Glen Eira."
