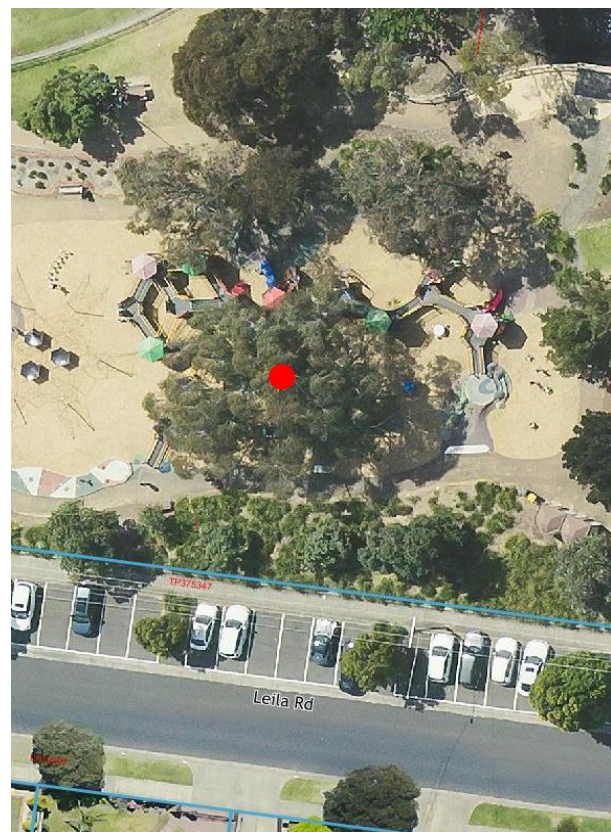


Photo 2: Red dot indicates location of Manna Gum

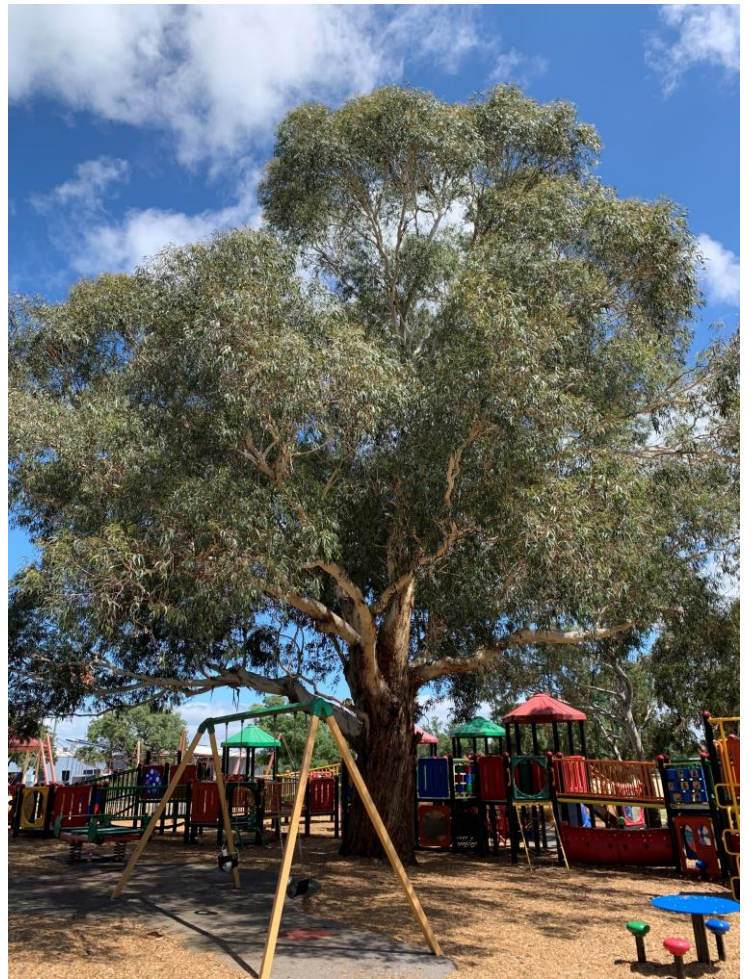


Photo 1: Manna Gum within playground of Packer Park

### Statement of significance:

This tree fulfils the criteria of:

- Unique Location or Context,
- Rare or Localised Distribution
- Particularly Old Specimen
- Outstanding Size
- Aesthetic Value
- Outstanding Example of Species
- Outstanding Habitat and Biodiversity Value

This mature Manna Gum is situated in a prominent and iconic position within public parkland and is one of only a few mature examples of this species within GECC. It is an old tree predating a lot of the development activity and urban subdivision in the area, and has a significant trunk girth and canopy spread. The canopy is entire and the tree provides a significant contribution to the neighbourhood character as an outstanding example of the species which attracts a range of native birdlife.
