"I remember standing in line to dive (or jump), for the first time, eventually getting my turn, slowly walking to the end of the plank and then turning back again, too frightened to do it. I did, however, eventually do it and what an experience that was for a young girl.

"Many days during school holidays and weekends were spent there, and I have fond memories, like many others, of sitting on the 'hill' with friends and enjoying the ambience of the surrounds.

"I look forward to replicating that feel in the redevelopment of Carnegie Memorial Swimming Pool."
