

# WHAT GOES IN EACH BIN?

## Green bin (food and garden waste) — collected weekly



- ✓ Vegetable and fruit scraps



- ✓ Meat scraps and bones



- ✓ Seafood scraps and shells



- ✓ Dairy leftovers and egg shells



- ✗ No plastic bags



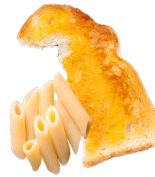
- ✓ Food waste wrapped in newspaper



- ✓ Garden waste



- ✓ Used paper towel and tissues



- ✓ Bread, pasta, cereal and rice

Biodegradable and compostable plastic bags can't be used in green bins. They will be sent to landfill.

## Yellow bin (recycling) — collected fortnightly



- ✓ Cardboard, paper, newspaper and envelopes



- ✓ Plastic bottles (bottles only, put lids in red bin)



- ✓ Glass bottles, jars and metal lids (empty and lids separated)



- ✗ No Fabric



- ✗ No batteries



- ✓ Plastic containers (clean and empty)



- ✓ Cartons (not long-life)



- ✓ Aluminium and tin cans



- ✗ No food scraps



- ✗ No plastic bags

## Red bin (general waste) — collected fortnightly



- ✓ Ceramics, crockery and glassware



- ✓ All coffee cups and lids



- ✓ Nappies and pet waste (wrapped)



- ✓ Polystyrene and foam packaging

You can also recycle soft plastics at Coles or Woolworths through the REDcycle program. Soft plastic is the kind you can scrunch.
