Please note: These fees do not apply to Home Care Packages and Full Cost Recovery charges. Council requires at least one business day notice for a service cancellation and if this is not received, the usual fee will apply. To access the services, people aged 65 years and over should contact My Aged Care on 1800 200 422 to establish eligibility for the services. People under 65 should contact Council's Service Centre on 9524 3333. These services are funded through a combination of client fees, Council, and either the *Commonwealth Home Support Programme* or the *Victorian Home and Community Care Program for Younger People*.
