Have you ordered your Crime Prevention Kit?

Council has partnered with Victoria Police, Neighbourhood Watch and the Neighbourhood House Network to develop the *Living Safely Program*. The *Program* aims to help reduce three of the most common crimes in Glen Eira — theft of items from cars, car theft and home burglary.

The *Program's* Crime Prevention Kit provides practical steps that you can take to help:

- keep your home and car safe and secure;
- deter opportunistic thieves; and
- prevent yourself from becoming a victim of crime.

The Crime Prevention Kit contains a home security checklist and a wheelie bin sticker containing crime prevention messages to remind residents and their neighbours to lock their homes and cars.
