

How to register your dog or cat

Register your dog or cat.

It is good to own a pet.

There are rules about owning a pet in Glen Eira.

You must register your dog or cat if it is older than 3 months.

If you have a dog or cat, it is the law to register them with Glen Eira Council.

If you do not register your pet, you may have to pay a fine.

When you register your dog or cat, you help keep it safe.

It is easier for us to help you find your pet if it gets lost.

It is also the law to microchip your dog or cat before you register it.

If this is the first time you have registered your dog or cat, you can pay for it:

- by mail (The address is: Glen Eira Town Hall, Corner Glen Eira and Hawthorn Roads, Caulfield, VIC 3162); or
- at our service centre at Town Hall (corner Glen Eira and Hawthorn Roads, Caulfield).

Do not pay by email. It is not safe.
