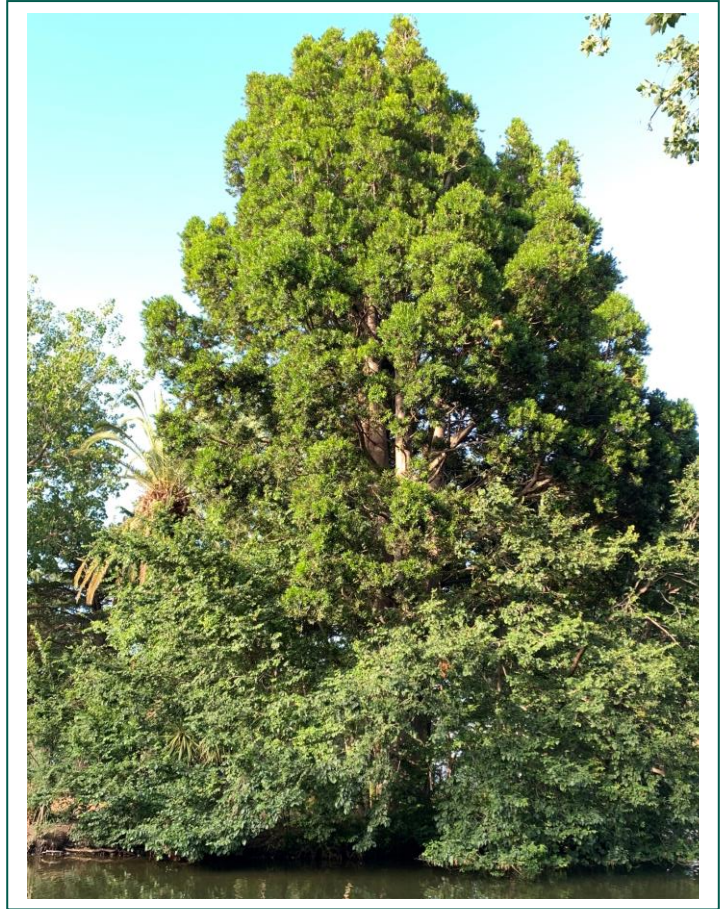

Statement of significance:

This tree fulfils the criteria of:

- Unique location or context
- Outstanding size (Girth height spread)
- Aesthetic value
- Outstanding habitat and biodiversity value

This tree is uniquely located on the island within the lake of the historically significant Caulfield Park. It is of outstanding size for height with the tree reaching above the surrounding trees and trunk girth which is in excess of 4m around.

The tree is a prominent and iconic feature of the park that has substantial aesthetic value as it makes a major contribution to the landscape.

As discussed in the 2018 Biodiversity in Glen Eira report, the island and all its trees have been documented as a roosting and breeding site for the Nankeen Night Heron.
