Statement of significance:

This tree fulfils the criteria of:

- Horticultural or genetic value
- Rare or localised distribution
- Particularly old specimen
- Outstanding Size (girth height spread)
- Aesthetic Value
- Outstanding Example of the Species

This Oak tree exhibits characteristics of both English Oaks and Algerian Oaks, indicating a hybridized specimen. This makes the tree significant for its horticultural and genetic value as well as its rarity as a unique specimen. The tree is also an outstanding example of a hybridized oak, with a large, healthy and well-formed canopy.

The tree is considered to be particularly old for an exotic specimen in the area, with indications it was planted shortly after the construction of the dwelling circa 1910. It is a particularly large, mature tree for the local area, with a wide spreading canopy and significant trunk girth.

This tree also makes a substantial contribution to the local landscape and neighbourhood character, providing amenity to the wider community.
