Registration period

Under the provisions of the *Domestic Animals Act 1994*, all dogs and cats three (3) months of age or over must be registered with Council.

Registration must be renewed annually by 10 April each year. Failure to register the dog or cat may incur a \$407 fine per animal. Council can not register a dog or cat that has not been implanted with a microchip.

Pensioner concession

If claiming a pensioner concession, proof of eligibility must be supplied (*State Concession Act 2004*).

Ownership

Under the *Domestic Animal Act 1994*, where the owner of a dog or cat is under the age of 18 years, the parent or guardian of that person is deemed to be the owner.

State Government Levy

A State Government Levy of \$4.64 per animal for registration is included in the fees. This Levy is primarily used to fund responsible pet ownership education programs.

Restricted breed

State Government has made legislation to restrict the American Pit Bull Terrier, Pit Bull Terrier, Dogo Argentino, Japanese Tosa, Fila Brasileiro, and Perro De Presa Canario.

Assistance dog

If your dog is trained to assist a person with a disability by performing specific tasks or functions, complete the Assistance Dog Application Form on our website.

Animal registration tag

Once your application is approved, you will receive an animal registration tag. Please note that all animal

renewal notices are sent from a 'no-reply' email address. For more information about animal registration, visit

Registration incentive schemes

Council offers two discount schemes to encourage residents to register their pets.

- Sterilised dogs and cats: if your pet is desexed within the first 12 months from the date of registration and you provide Council with a copy of the desexing certificate then the next years fees will be waived.
- Obedience trained dogs: if your pet has undertaken obedience training through an approved organisation, then you may be eligible for reduced fee. For list of approved organisations, visit www.agriculture.vic.gov.au

Privacy statement

The personal information on this form is required to include the dog or cat on the register administered by Council under the *Domestic Animals Act 1994*. This information is required under Section 10 of the Act and failure to provide the information may result in Council being unable to register your animal. The information is used by Council in connection with administration and enforcement of the Act, and may be disclosed to other councils.
