

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

YOUTH ART EXHIBITION 2026

Photographic images of artwork must be uploaded in a JPEG format no greater than 20 megabits.

Terms and conditions of entry:

1. Eligibility

- (a) Entrants must, live, work or study within the city of Glen Eira.
- (b) Entrants must be between five and 25 years old. Entrants under the age of 18 must obtain their parent or guardian's consent by way of signature where indicated below.

2. Entering the Exhibition

- (a) Entries will only be accepted via the online registration form within the published dates of open submissions 9am Monday 1 June to Wednesday 26 August 11:59am.
- (b) Entries are limited to one (1) artwork per entrant, with a maximum size of 100cm x 100cm. An "entry" must consist of a single, standalone artwork. This may include works created from multiple materials or elements within one piece (e.g. collage). However, submissions comprising multiple separate artworks, panels, canvases, photographs, or works forming a series will not be accepted as a single entry and may be deemed ineligible.
- (c) Entries must be the original artwork of the entrant, and any entries considered to be works of plagiarism will not be accepted. Entries that depict or promote violence, discrimination, sexually explicit content, or other material deemed inappropriate, offensive, or unsafe by the organiser will not be accepted.
- (d) Entries that are generated by Artificial Intelligence (AI) will not be accepted.
- (e) Entries must not have previously been awarded a prize in an event or competition held by Glen Eira City Council.
- (f) The artwork description must not exceed 80 words. Artwork will be displayed exactly as submitted. Entrants are solely responsible for the formatting and accuracy of their submission, including all details such as name, age, artwork title, description, and orientation. By submitting their artwork, entrants acknowledge and consent that it will be exhibited in its final submitted form.

- (g) By submitting an entry, all Entrants grant Council a worldwide, fee-free, transferable licence to use their entry for any purpose relating to Council's functions, including by publishing their entry on Council's print and social media. All Entrants further consent to any act or omission by Council which would otherwise constitute a breach of their moral rights.

3. Other people's rights

- (a) If an entry contains another individual's personal information (including their image) or another person's work, it is the entrant's responsibility to seek consent from those individuals. Glen Eira City Council may disqualify an entry if it becomes aware that an individual has not consented to their personal information or their work being included in the entry.

4. Exhibition and Prizes

- (a) Artwork must be submitted at the Town Hall Gallery at a determined time for the work to be displayed in the exhibition and considered for prizes as set out in this clause. Artists are responsible for collecting their artworks once the exhibition period has ended. All artworks not collected from the gallery by 5pm Sunday 11 October 2026 will be disposed of.
- (b) All accepted entries will be exhibited, and entrants acknowledged by name, at the Glen Eira City Council Gallery and winners will be exhibited on the Youth Services Instagram Page (@gleneiraartexpo).
- (c) At Council's discretion, entries may also be exhibited at a Council premises or on any of Council's internet platforms.
- (d) The Entrants will be sorted and judged by the following categories: s:
 - (i) Category 1: ages 5-9
 - (ii) Category 2: ages 10-13
 - (iii) Category 3: ages 14-17
 - (iv) Category 4: ages 18-25
- (e) Prizes:

- I. The winning entry in Category 1 will receive a prize to the value of \$100.00.
 - II. The winning entry in Category 2 will receive a prize to the value of \$150.00.
 - III. The winning entry in Category 3 will receive a prize to the value of \$250.00.
 - IV. The winning entry in Category 4 will receive a prize to the value of \$300.00 and be offered a solo exhibition in Gallery Two in 2027.
 - The exhibition is conditional upon the winner's availability and ability to meet all reasonable requirements associated with the exhibition.
- (f) In addition, an Open Award for an outstanding artwork utilising 3D material (including textiles and sculpture) will be presented, with a prize to the value of \$200.00. This award is open to all age categories.
The exhibition includes a People's Choice Award, whereby attendees may vote for their preferred work via a digital platform during the exhibition, which opens on Thursday 10 September. Voting is limited to one (1) vote per device until the floor talk at 12pm on Thursday, 24 September, at which time the winner will be announced
- (g) Council will allocate a judge with industry experience to determine the winners. Such determination is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- (h) Winners will be publicly announced during the Presentation Night on Monday 14 September and via Instagram on Tuesday 15 September. Names of the winners will be published in Glen Eira News, Instagram, and Glen Eira City Council Youth Service's Facebook page.
- (i) Winners may not exchange their prizes for money, and Council is not responsible for any loss suffered or incurred by any person in connection with or arising from redemption of any prize.
- (j) General
- i. If for any reason any aspect of this exhibition or competition is not capable of running as planned, including by reason of tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failure or any cause beyond the control of Council, Council may in its sole discretion cancel, terminate, modify or

suspend the exhibition or competition, or invalidate any affected entries, if required.

The personal information collected on this form is collected by Glen Eira City Council to administer participation in the 2026 Youth Art Exhibition. If you do not provide this information, it may not be possible to include your entry in the exhibition or the competition.
