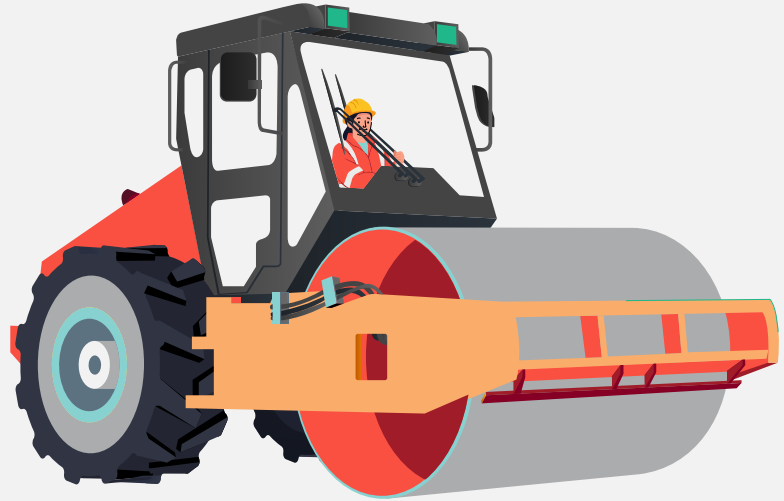


The new East Bentleigh Ambulance Branch is almost complete.

Centre Road will be closed in both directions on Sunday 6 September from 2am to 5pm for road works (weather dependent).



About your new East Bentleigh Ambulance Branch

Your new East Bentleigh Ambulance Branch features a four-bay garage for ambulances, four rest and recline areas for hard-working paramedics to recuperate, training facilities, a fully equipped kitchen and improved security and car parking to make sure paramedics are safe.

The new multi-million-dollar ambulance branch is on the Moorabbin Hospital campus near the corner of Gardeners Road and Centre Road, providing ease of access to main roads and major sites, including health services, schools, shopping precincts and community facilities.

The project is being delivered by the Victorian Health Building Authority (VHBA) in partnership with Ambulance Victoria.

What's happening

As part of the final stage of works, we installed underground cables for the new traffic signals on Centre Road, in front of the new ambulance branch.

To restore the road surface, it needs to be asphalted and line marked.

Centre Road will be closed while we undertake these important works.

Traffic management will be in place to minimise impacts and ensure the safety of pedestrians, cyclists, and road users.

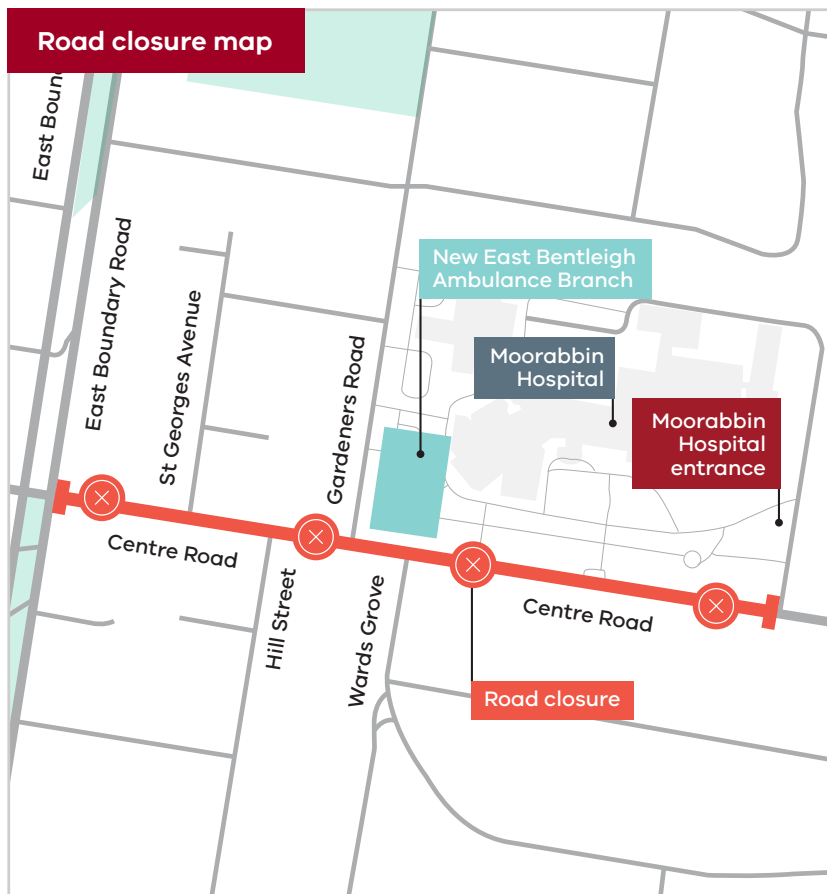
Works may be rescheduled due to inclement weather.

What to expect

- road closure and works from 2am to 5pm, Sunday 6 September 2026
- Centre Road closed in both directions between East Boundary Road and Moorabbin Hospital. Detours will be in place to guide traffic around the works via North Road and South Road. This is to avoid congestion on residential streets
- increased levels of noise and lights from heavy machinery and power tools (for the safety of workers on site, reversing beepers are required on all machinery)
- on-street parking restrictions
- access to Moorabbin Hospital will be maintained at all times.

Traffic management will be in place for properties on Centre Road within the immediate work zone to enter and exit at appropriate times during the works.

Additional single lane closures may be required over the coming months.
